MAINTENANCE REPORT: Haylon Thomas reported that the tin horn has been placed on Benny Stiles property, weeds are being sprayed, tree debris has been hauled away and continued mowing of the cemetary has been completed.

ANIMAL CONTROL REPORT: Haylon Thomas further reported that Animal Control picked up two dogs.

POLICE DEPARTMENT REPORT: Chief of Police Jess Wilson reported that his department received 362 contacts, 55 calls for service, 6 impounds and 2 vehicle releases.

FIRE DEPARTMENT REPORT: Fire Chief Tommy Mitchell reported that his department received 2 medical, 21 grass fires, and 1 vehicle fire. No structures were involved.

COMMUNITY CENTER REPORT: Laura Goss from the Nutrition Center reported that the newly hired employee is working out well at this time. The community kitchen will be placed back together now that all the required items have been ordered. She further noted that the ice maker is being installed on March 28th. M. Sexton noted that he is working on a bid for lightning protection for the Nutrition Center. JeriAnn Hasty reported that she will turn all expenses into our insurance company.






